The Worker Program creates a team of workers, counselors, and Food Service and Maintenance helpers and Administrators that work together to support the camp. As a team, the workers work in the kitchen (supporting the cooks & preparing meals) and on the grounds (maintaining camp property). The program cultivates efficient, selfless teamwork and strives to support the camp as needed. All training is on the job – no prior experience needed. Workers enjoy supervised evening store (one hour most nights) and one day off per week.

If you are applying **for more than one session**, indicate your choices with an **A, B, C**. You may be on a waiting list for your additional choices to allow as many people as possible to have this opportunity.

Dear Prospective Worker,

As you may know the worker program has been integrated with teams of guys and gals working together in the kitchen and on the grounds crew. This summer, the worker program will continue in the integrated format. No prior experience in a kitchen or on a grounds crew is needed in order to be a worker. Each crew works as a team that accomplishes the various tasks together in order to fulfill camp's needs and have fun.

The worker program is an excellent exposure to how CEDARS operates. It is also a very natural, and increasingly integrated, stepping-stone to becoming a future counselor. In fact, we regard it as part of a three or four part preparation or training curriculum for future leaders. Sr. Counselor applicants at CEDARS (and elsewhere) are always more highly regarded and more quickly hired, if they have participated in CEDARS' Jr. Leadership program, CEDARS' Worker Training program, CEDARS' Counselor-In-Training course and then paid as a CEDARS' Jr. Counselor. The Worker Training part of this sequence focuses on teamwork and aims to serve specific needs of the camp. Interaction with the camp – with each other, other staff, campers, and parent helpers – is cherished. Being a worker is an integral step of a long term CEDARS' experience, not to mention the fun, adventure and camaraderie that is always involved.

As you make your 2010 summer plans, please also consider other benefits of the worker program: free room and board; some tuition credit; a few days off to enjoy Big Surf and choice activities (within reason); training in kitchen operation, food prep, maintenance equipment/machinery; and two weeks of classic memories with old and new friends. Many people do both the worker and a camper program such as Jr. Leadership, a Sports Camp, Musical Theater, Adventure Riding Camp, English ARC, ARC Wild West, WIT, WEW, Adventure Bible & Drama Camp, or Ski Camp. Your worker credits may be applied as tuition credits to any of these programs for yourself or for a sibling, if you are an especially giving brother or sister.

We hereby officially extend a warm invitation to you to literally make 2010 your “best summer yet” by sending in your application to be a worker! We look forward to receiving you application soon, and welcome you to bring other CEDARS friends and make new ones.
